**UNION COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION AWARDS GRANT TO  
MIFFLINBURG BUGGY MUSEUM IN SUPPORT OF LECTURE SERIES**

LEWISBURG, PA – The Union County Community Foundation has awarded a \$1,500 grant to the Mifflinburg Buggy Museum in support of the “Experience the Civil War” Commemorative Series. The grant will provide support for a year-long series of special exhibits, lectures, and other activities.

Representatives of the Union County Community Foundation (UCCF) Advisory Board presented the grant award to Bronwen Sanders, Executive Director of the museum. The program will benefit area residents by providing educational and cultural opportunities, and will provide new opportunities to promote tourism in Union County.

The UCCF has a competitive application process for grants from its unrestricted funds. The next grant application deadline is October 1, 2006.
