**FIRST COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF PENNSYLVANIA
WELCOMES YVONNE MORGAN TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

WILLIAMSPORT, PA – The Board of Directors of the First Community Foundation of Pennsylvania (FCFPA) recently appointed Yvonne Morgan as the Foundation’s newest Director. She will also serve concurrently as a Director of the Union County Community Foundation (UCCF) Advisory Board.

Morgan has been appointed to serve a four-year term, which is renewable for an additional four years. She was appointed as the first representative of the Union County Community Foundation on the FCFPA Board of Directors. Members of the Union County Community Foundation Advisory Board recommended her for the appointment.

Morgan commented, “I am pleased to be a part of the Union County Community Foundation, and to serve as the first representative from the UCCF on the First Community Foundation of Pennsylvania Board of Directors.”

Frank J. Concino, Jr., President and CEO of the Foundation, said, “The Foundation welcomes Yvonne Morgan as its newest Board member. Her background of service to many organizations in the community makes her an asset to both the Union County Community Foundation Advisory Board, and now the First Community Foundation Advisory Board.”

Morgan brings a diverse range of community service experience to the Board. She co-founded the Lewisburg Area Community Center to focus on the social needs of the community, with a special emphasis on youth. She also co-founded the Union County Youth Commission, a

mentoring program for first-time juvenile offenders. She has also served on the Lewisburg Borough Council, and continues to serve on the Board of Directors of the Downtown Partnership.

Morgan began her career in the nursing field, and worked in hospitals in the United States and Germany before becoming the Office Manager and Nurse for her husband's general surgery practice. She owned and managed her own business, Write Now Printers, until 1992, and worked as a wardrobe consultant from 1993-1999. Since then, Morgan has devoted her time to statewide political activism. She serves as the Central Pennsylvania coordinator for the Pennsylvania Club for Growth, a nonpartisan organization that has the primary goal of smaller government.

The First Community Foundation of Pennsylvania, founded in 2004, has three affiliates: the Williamsport-Lycoming Community Foundation, the Danville Area Community Foundation, and the Union County Community Foundation.
